## "YOU ARE A BAD PRIEST YOU NEVER INVITED US"

A priest will always meet with Christians who will blame him for not inviting them to important church occasions. I remember some people from this part of the city who of late blamed me for not sending them invitation cards for the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the consecration of our church two years ago. One man said to me:

"You are a bad man, we heard about the celebration and we waited for the invitation card but you never sent us one; St Mary's was our church and it still remains our church even though we now live in the other part of the city we felt let down when you never sent us invitation cards to such a church function!"

I assured the men that the invitation cards were sent and that they had been keeping them for many years. "Look here Joseph" I said to one of them, "you were invited 69 years ago and for the last 69 years you have not taken notice of it." He thought I was joking and I'm sure you might think so as well.

Have you ever thought that when we were baptized we received "invitation Cards" summoning us to every function in the Church? Many people might forget that by baptism we became members of a family of God, we are expected to take interest in every affair of the church and to get involved as much as we can. In ordinary life, family members are not invited to family functions, this is taken for granted, it is those outside the family who are invited. A baptized Christian who waits for an invitation in order to participate in the life and activities of the church, has not understood what baptism meant and what the baptismal card entitles one to. If we take this notion seriously we realize that to sit on the fence when there is an issue to be solved or an activity to be done in the church is a lack of understanding of the meaning of our baptism in practice.

There are many services to be carried out in the church but these can only be done if we understand that by virtue of our baptism it is our duty to do them. If you drive to Sunday Mass, it becomes a Christian duty to help someone to go to Mass. Are you a singer, it becomes a Christian duty to praise the Lord through song. Has God given you a voice to read, it becomes your Christian duty to proclaim the Word of God. Do you have some free time, giving some of it to your church becomes a Christian duty. Yes baptism exposed us to all sorts of good work in the church.

Am I a bad priest if I did not invite you? No! but you are a bad Christian to have the invitation (Baptismal) card and not show up!

Is any parishioner sick or in hospital Please inform the Parish Priest or one of the Sisters. It is important that Catholics on admission to hospital tell their religion to be recorded and request a visit from the Catholic Chaplain.
