## THESE ARE WONDERFUL IDEAS FROM POLITICIANS

Some years ago I travelled on a bus where a gang of youth defied the law by smoking on the bus. The driver was helpless so were some few passengers we noticed that the gang was after something all they wanted was provocation. We just kept quiet but we almost died of suffocation. Before smoking in enclosed public places was banned, some friends invited me for a meal in a pub; gosh the smoke from cigarettes formed a thick cloud in the whole place that it took a lot of washing to get it out of my clothes and body. Thanks to the medics who successfully argued that smoking was dangerous not only to the smoker but even to those around. The banning of smoking in pubs and on buses are wonderful legislations we ever received from politicians, you know that it takes us long to get such positive compliments.

There is another great idea that our politicians thought out best GIFT AID. Gift Aid allows individuals who are subject to UK income tax to complete a simple, short declaration that they are a UK taxpayer. Any cash donations that the taxpayer makes to the charity after making a declaration are treated as being made after deduction of income tax at the basic rate, and the charity can reclaim the basic rate income tax paid on the gift from HMRC. For a basic-rate taxpayer, this adds approximately 25% to the value of any gift made under Gift Aid. This weekend at all Masses Mrs. Roisin Byrne will talk to us about Gift Aid.

The Gift Aid envelopes for the new tax year are being handed out at the back of church this weekend. Please do not forget to collect yours if you are already in the scheme.

For those who are not signed up and are paying tax on their earnings or pensions, I would urge you to do so. For every pound you donate, we get an extra 25p at no extra cost to you. It increases the value of your donations by 25%.

It is very easy to join. All you have to do is sign a form and use a set of special envelopes to put your donation into the weekly offertory collection. You do not have to provide any personal details such as your earnings. You also do not have to commit to a set amount. You can stop and start again as your finances allow.

If just 20% of our parishioners who are taxpayers but currently donate to the church in loose collection signed up for Gift Aid, we would receive around an extra £1,000 a year which I am sure you will agree is a significant sum of money.

Is any parishioner sick or in hospital? Please inform the Parish Priest or one of the Sisters. It is important that Catholics on admission to hospital tell their religion to be recorded and request a visit from the Catholic Chaplain.

## Other Matters of Importance

Remembering Rwanda: Sunday - April 6th - will mark 20 years since the start of the genocide in Rwanda. Within 100 days after the plane crash of the then president Juvenal Habyarimana in an apparent assassination, at least 800,000 people were murdered in cold blood, and hundreds of thousands more were forced to flee into neighbouring countries. To know the magnitude of this event, 8000people were killed per day, 333 per hour or 5 per minute! But this period also saw many incredible acts of bravery from individuals protecting their neighbours, and a tremendous show of solidarity and compassion from the Catholic community in England and Wales, which raised £6 million for CAFOD's relief effort without CAFOD even launching an appeal. In the 20 years since the genocide, there has been remarkable process of forgiveness and reconciliation in communities torn apart by the awful violence of 1994. On this fifth Sunday of Lent let us remember to pray for Rwanda and for all countries afflicted by conflicts that there may be peace.
