WE ARE CALLED TO COMPLETE THIS JIGSAW

Next Saturday will be our last Saturday for Sunday Mass at 6:00pm. I feel so sorry that we are losing one of our favorite Masses that has been attended by many people over the years. The Archbishop took into consideration the needs of every parish in relationship with the available resources in the provision of priests in the diocese. I fully believe that he looked at the general picture of the diocese rather than to the individual needs of a particular parish. Is this signaling to greater things to come?

Here at our parish, the number of Christians coming to the Saturday 6:00 o'clock Mass had dropped for two major reasons both of which are understandable.

First: God has called to himself many of those parishioners who used to come to the Saturday 6:00 O'clock Mass: here I recall Christians like Bill & Bridie Clisham, Johanna and Martin Ward, Joan McCann, Anna Mara, Catherine Leslie, John Ledwidge, Rose Roach, Alec and Marie Garner to mention but a few. Unfortunately these faithful servants of St. Mary's are not replaced!

The other reason for the number of Saturday 6:00 O'clock Mass to drop is the fact that many have become housebound. Having served the Lord faithfully and making innumerable sacrifices and journeys to and from the church, they cannot do so any longer; their ministry to the Church is mainly confined in their homes. In preparation for this time which I foresaw coming, our church has a system now that Mass can be broadcast live to the sick and housebound through the internet www.mcnmedia.tv Mcn Media Church Services-Webcams-Live Streaming. The loss of one of our Masses should not be cause for tearing our community apart. Many parishioners who support good causes in the parish such as Bonus Ball, Family draw, Cake sales, annual Christmas bazaar, preparing and organizing parish dances are drawn from this group. I pray that for love of our parish we continue to support it by adjusting to the two Masses we are given.

We shall try to keep the Sunday 9:30am Mass as short as possible preferable within the hour so as to enable people who have to go to work or to travel to get away. Sometimes the big numbers of people at Mass makes it long, this is understandable and we are grateful to God for it. Let us try to maintain our community of St. Mary's; we have come a long way. St. Mary's has stood by us. Let us stand by this good work that the Lord has given to us on trust.

Is any parishioner sick or in hospital Please inform the Parish Priest or one of the Sisters. It is important that Catholics on admission to hospital tell their religion to be recorded and request a visit from the Catholic Chaplain.
