ST. OSBURG'S PARISH

The following Statement has appeared in the Parish newsletter of St. Osburgs this weekend which I would request you to place in your prayers.

The Archbishop has appointed the Apostles of Jesus Missionaries to the Parish of St Osburgs. They already serve at SS Mary & Benedict and St Elizabeth. They have requested their superiors to send three more priests to our Diocese. Once more there will be a Religious Community looking after St Osburgs Parish. The Benedictine Monks ministered here from 1807 until 1991. After the War the house was built as a Priory for the Religious Community. Father Jimmy Lutwama, who is the superior of the Apostles of Jesus Missionaries in England and Wales will be responsible for the parish. He will be assisted by Fr Moses Pitya, his assistant zone superior. They intend to retain and build on the good traditions in the parish. Father Michael Stack will be moving to live in the Presbytery at St Anne's, which is nearer to the Hospital. He will continue with his full time, and much appreciated, ministry as Catholic Chaplain to The University Hospital."

This announcement has taken me by surprise but it reminds us of the reasons why we need to support the promotion of vocations and the formation of priests. Being a priest and a missionary myself, I have some wider knowledge of what is going on in the world as far as evangelization is concerned. I'm pleased that many of you are making some initiatives (making and buying cakes, organising charity dance, making charity walk, support the formation of a missionary priest box) to support the formation of a missionary priest box) to support the formation of a missionary priest program. We need to wake up to the reality of life, we need to avoid the catastrophe of famine, the devastation of hunger; hunger not of bread, thirst not of water but of hearing the word of God (Amos 8:11).

The new responsibilities entrusted to me and to Fr. Moses will call for some changes in the parishes we are already ministering to. As missionaries we know the cost of establishing a parish but we know the painful consequences of closing a parish on the souls of the faithful. We shall endeavour to avoid that. It is our desire that each parish under our pastoral care retains its identity and that the rich traditions of each parish are preserved. I turn to you my parishioners to support me in the upkeep of St. Osburgs until that parish gets its own resident priests.

Is any parishioner sick or in hospital Please inform the Parish Priest or one of the Sisters. It is important that Catholics on admission to hospital tell their religion to be recorded and request a visit from the Catholic Chaplain.
