WE ARE NOT WASTED LOT

A story is told of a man who carried a stick across his shoulders with two pots hanging on either side; one pot was new but the other was old, half cracked and was losing water. The cracked pot used to glance at the good one with sadness until one day it told its owner how useless it felt due to its age and the cracks; I'm not useful to anyone any more' it lamented.

But the man was not happy to hear negative self-portrait of the pot that had served him faithfully for many years. 'I will fill you with water as I normally do' he said 'and take you home but as we go look at the flowers growing along the way.' The old pot looked at them: they were beautiful and strong but realizing its fragile state it insisted I am worthless!

Reaching home the man asked: "did you notice that flowers grew only on your side of the way"? I knew you are fragile and broken in many places but you are very useful and you can still give life to others, as water dripped from you these plants grew and produced flowers which are picked and taken to decorate the altar.

Speaking to some of my parishioners some have a feeling that either because they are no longer physically strong enough, or because it is long since they have been away from the Christian faith, they are no longer good contributors to the Church's growth, beauty and holiness. The truth is that in our own imperfections and weaknesses God's grace is fully revealed. We are not a wasted lot. When we come into the presence of the Lord, he will not expect anyone of us to be without bruises and cracks, these will be signs of battles well fought for love and in service of him. Years before the coming of guns in Uganda people used shields and spears for battle, a shield that had fought many battles was seen by the number of wounds inflicted on it, its owner was then very proud of it because it fought his battles and protected him. 'Scars,' 'bruises' and 'cracks' will be proofs of our fidelity to Jesus,

We are so lucky to have a mixture of elderly and young people in the parish especially at Sunday Masses because we can get assurances from each other. Many youth at Mass bring joy in the hearts of the elders because it tells them that they have not wasted their time following Jesus since many young people want to do the same. On the other hand seeing elderly people in the church reminds young people that following Jesus is not a one-off event but a lifelong commitment. It goes without saying that our very being here today speaks volumes!

<u>Saint of the Week</u>: John Henry Newman was born in London in 1801 and for 20 years he was an Anglican priest. His study of history of the Church led him towards Catholicism and in 1845 he was received into the Catholic Church. In 1847 he was ordained Catholic priest and went on to found the Oratory of St. Philip Neri in England. He was an influential writer on a variety of subjects. And composed beautiful hymns some of which we sing in our Parish liturgy. In 1879 he was created Cardinal by Pope Leo the XIII. He is praised for his humility and contribution to the intellectual life of the Church. He died in Birmingham 11the Aug. 1890. He was beatified in our presence by Pope Benedict XVI at ceremony in Birmingham on 19th September 2010.
