TRUSTING IN GOD WILL TRANSFORM OUR PARISH:

This week on the 4th of September 2014 marked 10 years since the Sisters of St. Anne of Providence (our parish Sisters) opened a mission in England when they sent three of their members, namely Sr. Leena Mathias and Sr. Lydwin Lewis. They arrived at St. Hubert's Parish Oldbury on this date. The Sisters left their country India fully convinced that God had chosen and consecrated them for a mission which he would show them.

In God's infinite providence he had in mind that the Sisters were to work in our parish because immediately when the Sisters arrived in Oldbury, Sr. Anne Marie and Imelda who had worked in our parish for 19 years and belonged to the Sisters of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart (Ireland) wanted to leave St. Mary's for good due to age. Sr Imelda and Anne Marie were greatly missed by the parish but God consoled her by the arrival of the Sisters of St. Anne of Providence.

Unlike other parishes, I have a feeling that St. Mary's Church enjoys a privileged position in the hearts of people. Our parish has also had real tragedies like the untimely death of our second Parish Priest Fr. William IIdephonsus Campbell whose boat was sank by enemy fire in the Irish Sea during the First World War 1918 and the untimely death of Fr. Harkin who died in the gas explosion in the presbytery on 12th March 1985. If we try to imagine how the members of this parish received this tragic news, it must have been a very difficult time. What made them to remain firm was their trust in God. Trusting God simply believes that He loves us, that He has the power to help us, that He *wants* to help us and that he will help us. We trust our friends, the bank, the stock market or the government more than we trust God and His Word.

By the end of this Month, Coventry Catholic Deanery will lose a number of Masses including our Sat. 6:00 O'clock Mass. I think there is something the Lord is communicating to us; we are living in the land of material abundance but there is a great famine raging in our land a famine not of food a draught not of water but for hearing the word of God as Prophet Amos prophesied (Amos 8:11)..

The 10 years of our parish Sisters in this country is yet another sign that God is in charge, if we learn to trust in him I'm sure God will transform our hearts and by transforming our hearts, he will transform our parish.
