8th FEB. FIRST INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER AGAINST HUMAN TRAFFICKING

On 3rd Feb 2015 a press conference was held in the Holy See Press Office to launch the first International Day of Prayer and Awareness against Human Trafficking. This weekend Sunday 8th on the feast of a Sudanese slave Josephine Bakhita a slave and victim of human trafficking, the church calls upon us to realize the evil of human trafficking. It is not difficult to find someone who was taken into a country with false promise of a better life; only to find that money and passports are taken away leaving the victims virtually stateless and in slavery! The Day is promoted by the Pontifical Council for the Pastoral Care of Migrants, the Pontifical Council "Justice and Peace" and the International Union of Superiors General (UISG).

The launch was attended by Cardinal Joao Braz de Aviz, prefect of the Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life; Cardinal Antonio Maria Veglio, president of the Pontifical Council for the Pastoral Care of Migrants and Cardinal Peter Kodwo Appiah Turkson, president of the Pontifical Council of Justice and Peace.

If you thought slave trade and bonded labor is a thing of the past, think again, millions of people today are deprived of freedom and are forced to live in slavery. The Mediterranean Sea and Pacific Ocean have become grave yards for victims of human trafficking. The Holy Father invites us all to recognize that we are facing a global phenomenon which exceeds the competence of any one community or country. Our awareness must expand and extend to the very depths of this evil; from awareness to prayer ... from prayer to solidarity ... and from solidarity to concerted action, until slavery and trafficking are no more". Human trafficking is a modern form of slavery, some people are brainwashed and trafficked to go and commit crime in foreign countries. Let us reflect and pray in order to cast light on this crime.

"O God, when we hear of children and adults deceived and taken to unknown places for purposes of sexual exploitation, forced labor, and organ 'harvesting', our hearts are saddened and our spirits angry that their dignity and rights are ignored through threats, lies, and force. We cry out against the evil practice of this modern slavery, and pray with St. Bakhita for it to end. Give us wisdom and courage to reach out and stand with those whose bodies, hearts and spirits have been so wounded, so that together we may make real your promises to fill these sisters and brothers with a love that is tender and good. Send the exploiters away empty-handed to be converted from this wickedness, and help us all to claim the freedom that is your gift to your children. Amen".

Never invite unexpected visitors into your home; use a door chain, keep them out and ask for ID if they claim to be from a company.
