#### THIS KIND OF STARVATION IS BY PERSONAL CHOICE

People who live in the real world understand and interpret things differently from people who live in imaginary world. Those who live in a 'rhetorical world,' have answers to every question they can solve every problem and have a name for everything; unfortunately it is all words and often empty words! People who live in 'imaginary world' will think that things are better the other side or that things are the way they are because someone has disturbed the waters! People who live in the 'real world 'grasp the meaning of everything, they do not need much explanation.

Today is Corpus Christi, Jesus present among us as our food of life. He spent much time talking about himself as the Bread of life. Unless you eat my flesh and drink my blood you will not have life in you, in other words you will die. Jesus was talking about the real world where starvation causes not rhetorical or imaginary death but real death. Spiritual starvation leads to spiritual eternal death. Jesus has given us the means o escape that kind of death in the Eucharist.

During this Year of Mercy Jesus through his vicar on Earth Pope Francis, has declared an Amnesty for Sin. He has also appointed in each diocese priests who he named as "Ambassadors of Mercy". Their work is to hear Confessions and to absolve every sin. In Coventry deanery Fr. Moses Pitya AJ and Tony Norton are our Ambassadors of Mercy.

There are a number of us who do not receive Holy Communion year after year. This Year of Mercy should not see you stay away from Holy Communion . I know of so many good people among you my parishioners whose marriages are not blessed in the Church. This might be one of the reasons why you do not go for Holy Communion. Why don't you come and we talk this over! During this Year of Mercy (which will soon close) it is time to take advantage of it by making good every reason that would keep us from participating at the table of Jesus. I'll be very pleased to help out the couples who are married civilly but not in the Church wo would wish to have their marriages blessed. Yes I want you to receive Holy Communion. If you do not correct whatever keeps you from Holy Communion, then know that this kind of starvation is by your choice unfortunately it leads to spiritual death.
