Here in Coventry the door of Mercy and Shrine of Pilgrimage for Christ's faithful is at St. Mary's and Benedict Church Raglan Street. The ceremony to open the door of Mercy will be led by all the priests of the denary on Sunday 13th starting at 3:00O, Clock.. All are invited to attend.
